What is the genre of the film and how is this genre shown in the opening?	Action. Shown through fast-paced and energetic music (rock), bright colours, fast cars, and a tense bank heist scene that builds suspense and excitement

Questions	Answer including clear, specific examples of the text
What is the genre of the film and how is this genre shown in the opening?	Science fiction/thriller. Shown through surreal visuals (waves crashing inside a room), a mysterious tone, and cryptic dialogue about dreams and reality.
What is the target audience of the film and how can you tell this from the opening?	Older teens and adults who enjoy complex narratives and psychological thrillers. The intellectual themes and serious tone appeal to a mature audience.
What is introduced in the opening? (e.g. characters, themes, setting plot)	Main character, the theme of dream vs reality, the mysterious idea of “inception,” and a shifting, dreamlike setting.

Are there any narrative devices used? (e.g. flash backs, nonlinear storytelling, voiceover)	Nonlinear storytelling and time jumps – the audience is dropped into a scene with no clear context, prompting questions about what’s real.
How are micro elements used in the opening to communicate information/contribute to the mood?	Low lighting, muted colour palette, disorienting camera angles, and ominous music create a sense of mystery and tension.
How are the credits presented in the opening sequence? What is the visual style of the credits and how does it align with the overall tone?	Minimal or no opening credits – the focus is on immersing the viewer in the dreamlike story, matching the disorienting tone.

Questions	Answer including clear, specific examples of the text
What is the genre of the film and how is this genre shown in the opening?	Horror/thriller. Shown through bleak colours, isolated suburban setting, eerie music, and a sudden violent kidnapping.
What is the target audience of the film and how can you tell this from the opening?	Adults and teens who enjoy psychological thrillers and horror with social commentary. The tension and realistic setting suggest a mature audience.
What is introduced in the opening? (e.g. characters, themes, setting plot)	A lone Black man walking in a white suburb, setting up themes of racism, danger in the mundane, and being out of place.
Are there any narrative devices used? (e.g. flash backs, nonlinear storytelling, voiceover)	Foreshadowing . the opening sets up the danger and mood that may appear later in the film.
How are micro elements used in the opening to communicate information/contribute to the mood?	Dim lighting, long tracking shots, ambient sounds, the white car and masked kidnapper create fear and suspense.

How are the credits presented in the opening sequence? What is the visual style of the credits and how does it align with the overall tone?

Simple and minimalistic. The credits don't distract from the unsettling mood and eerie tone of the opening.
